The REWA unit of Purulia distributed clothes to the poor women, children and the needy in the Kudlum village/slum area near Purulia City. This activity was carried out by a mission named as **Project Arpan** on 7th January, by a team of twenty members including REWA - Purulia Branch head Ms. Ruby Sultania and chief advisor REWA - Ms. Manju Jalan. As a part of its objective, mission



and social responsibilities, REWA - Purulia regularly organizes and participates in several activities aimed at the uplift of society. Recognizing the unfortunate situations faced by the poor people, especially children, REWA team decided to distribute the cloths and lend them a helping hand. These women and children are unable to purchase their winter clothes and belong to very poor background. Therefore, REWA decided to support them in times of need with compassion and kindness. Activity

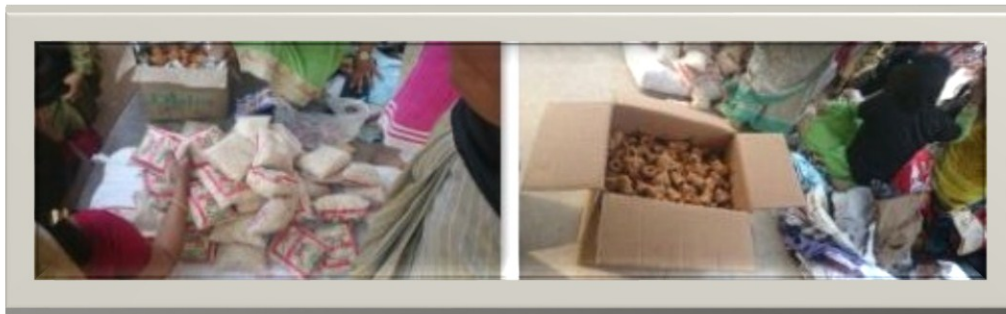
